We want to know how you feel about the meeting, so that we can make meetings like this better. Please answer the questions below and on the back of this page. **It should only take about five minutes.**

What is this survey?

We are trying a new way of doing these meetings, and we want to know what you thought about today's meeting. The Minnesota State Interagency Committee (MnSIC) and the school district are trying to find ways to make IEP meetings better. You do not have to take this survey. The only thing that will happen if you don't take this survey is that we won't have your thoughts to help us change things.

Who can see what I answered?

MnSIC will get a copy of your answers to this survey, but your answers won't be tied to your name or the student's name. Management Analysis and Development (MAD) is in charge of this survey and will collect everyone's answers. MAD is a team of people in state government that is different from MnSIC. MAD will share what you answered with MnSIC, except for anything you write that might tell us who you are.

Information that could reasonably be used to identify you based on your response is considered private data under the Minnesota Government Data Practices Act (Minnesota Statutes § 13.64), meaning MAD will not share it with others except as provided by law.
